

Statement Regarding Postponement of the 2020 WRRI Annual Conference UPDATED: March 11, 2020

Dear WRRI Conference Attendees and the NC Water Resources Community,

In light of NC State University's announcement today of new policies, NC WRRI will postpone the 2020 Annual Conference that had been set for March 18-19 in Raleigh. To encourage social distancing, "effective immediately and until further notice, NC State is prohibiting on-campus events, meetings and gatherings of more than 100 people."
